

2025 Spotlight of the Double-Digit Influence of the Numerological Universal Year

The Universal Year is simply based on the addition of the numbers in the year, which is why 2025 is a Universal 9-Year ($2 + 0 + 2 + 5 = 9$) and we can therefore generally anticipate synchronicities that align with it.

Yet, there is ever-another number that influences each year and that is the preceding number because it is when Winter Solstice occurs, which can be accurately understood as the 'natural' New Year. What this reveals is that each event technically occurs in different years on the calendar. In other words, the Numerology of Winter Solstice each year counts at the numerological year number that precedes that of January 1st.

TI have observed that the interplay between Winter Solstice, which occurs on December 21st, (or the 20th or 22nd, depending on where one is located in the world, but usually on the 21st in Greenwich U.K.) also marks the official location of 0 Longitude for the world. In this regard, it is the official location for when the exact strike of midnight occurs when December 31st becomes January 1st.

The main point is that each year, we are experiencing the interplay of two Universal Year numbers! Beyond apparently superficial considerations, that fact that the Universal Year of Winter Solstice, which I have for many years referred to as the 'Natural New Year', is the number prior to that of the January 1st New Year, which means that both numbers hold their own distinct significance. This significance of these numerological factors will, therefore, invariably be expressed in the Astrological themes of the year, as well.

So, there is the Numerology of the year based on Winter Solstice, or of the Natural New Year, and of January 1st, which can be described as the official calendar New Year, but which is not 'natural', is not based on nature but is what can be described as a socially and politically 'contrived' date. My focus is not to judge or criticize this now well-established social and political which finds its origins in Rome and directly associated with the Gregorian Calendar, which has emerged to become the global standard.

Every country in the world is now 'plugged into' the Gregorian Calendar, so to speak. Whatever else might be said about the history or the social revolution or evolution of this fact, it should be noted that achieving the exactitude of this calendar, which is based on the very precise measurement of the Sun's light in its intimate relationship with planet Earth, has been a central goal of astronomers for over 4 centuries as established by Pope Gregory the VIII, but which actually finds its roots 1000 years earlier when Pope Gregory I, issued the edict to convert the largely pagan Anglo-Saxons of England to Christianity.

The significance of this now world-wide, collective reality which is so significantly a feature of the current state of the human condition, is made that much more relevant since it constitutes the roots of the English language, which is now the global standard. The main point is that each year we experience two New Years, Winter Solstice which is the 'natural' and January 1st, which is what can be described as the social, yet now 'official' start.

The significance of this basic fact includes another important distinction which is that each year Winter Solstice occurs at a slightly DIFFERENT TIME. Explaining why is quite complex but is neither necessary to make the point. Unlike the strike of midnight on January 1st, (which it is true is also subject to one's specific time zone base on where they are located in the world at that time) always occurs at 00:00:01 or the stroke of midnight, marking the time of the event of the exact moment of the Calendar New Year.

So, Winter Solstice marks the time and event of the 'Natural New Year' which is always very close to December 21st, but always at a slightly different time. On the other hand, the official or 'Calendar New Year' always occurs at the strike of Midnight, or 00:00:01 on January 1st.

It is noteworthy that the Winter Solstice or the Natural New Year occurs almost exactly 10 days prior to the stroke of midnight on January 1st, making each day its own countdown from 10 to 0. But the most important take away point is that while the Calendar New Year is the official and is the primary focus of the countries and populations of the world, or the global majority, Winter Solstice remains the anchor of the natural, seasonal cycle. What is important about this is that I have come to the strong consideration that the power of the number of Winter Solstice holds more weight or at least equal weight to that of the January 1st year number count.

The take-away is that the themes that will unfold over the course of every year host those associated with two respective numerological factors. In 2025 the two numbers are 8 and 9. What this suggests is that 2025 will indeed be extra powerful. We will still experience the themes of ending, completion and graduation associated with 9, yet the 8, the number of power and abundance, (the big tent, exam time, the playoffs...), associated with Winter Solstice 2024 will deliver its own payload of power and intensity associated with 8.

So, while recognition of these themes is somewhat subtle and it does require some degree of background awareness, the following guideline will support your observations.

Basic Themes associated with each Numerological Year Influence.

1 = New beginnings and an impulse to take new leads, strides and initiatives. This can require extra energy, determination and resolve.

2 = Focus on balancing and feeling solid based on what began in the previous 1-year and with close attention to the details.

3 = Expansion and creative self-expression with a keen determination to be seen, heard, acknowledged and celebrated.

4 = Stabilization and focus to assert even more practical strategies.

5 = The urge to be freedom-oriented, liberated and more experiential and experimental.

6 = The realization that you must decide and commit more fully thus directing more energy to certain projects and relationships at subsequently less time and energy on others, or bringing those projects and relationships to a close as you commit to the others.

7 = Processes of initiation during which time that the flow of circumstances include important experiences that push us to 'take the initiative to be initiated and/or experiencing strong feelings of the need to 'feel the fear but do it anyway'.

8 = Abundance and culmination, yet also tests and persevering to overcome the past and prevail to attain greater heights of achievement and success.

9 = Endings, completions, graduations and the feeling of fatigue with various matters and orientations, generally, or the feeling of being done and no longer feel inspired or interested or energized to continue.
