

The Spiritual Core and Value of Horoscopes

Horoscopes have more value than mere entertainment, just as is true of Astrology in general. Both are ancient and time-proven methods of gaining insight, guidance, self-awareness, inspiration and entertainment. A Horoscope can be written for any given time period – a day, week, month, season, year or even longer. The length of time-period determines the focus of the scope...

Horoscopes are very popular in our culture. Most people at least know their sign, which is their "Sun" Sign. The Horoscope is largely based on your Sun Sign. Traditionally, people turn to their Horoscope for entertainment. Yet, unfortunately, people are often left disappointed by reading their Horoscope, and thereby join the ranks of sceptics and critics who deem Horoscopes and Astrology in general as nonsense, but not always.

When a Horoscope proves accurate, however, it can come as a shock and a surprise, even to many Astrologers. "A lucky hit or sheer coincidence" some will say. When the Horoscope reveals strong semblances of accuracy in terms of trends and life growth processes on a consistent basis, like week after week, month after month and year after year, people consciously and subconsciously begin to re-question previous assumptions and biases upheld by the so-called intellectual elites of society.

They begin to recognize that there is actually something to Astrology despite what they were told. Some might even question those who assert that Horoscopes are, and more specifically, Astrology is nonsense or non-scientific. The irony is that although science is upheld as revealing truths, it is based on a linear, materialistic paradigm and those who subscribe to it without question or consideration of anything existing outside of it are subject to bias and cognitive dissonance. Good science serves us well, but the notion that it can ascertain all truth is a delusion.

The deeper fact is that Astrology works, and so too do simple Horoscopes, based on another paradigm which is generally referred to as holism. Within this context, Horoscope entries categorized as signs are fractals of the whole. The term fractal is generally associated with mathematics and a branch of it referred to as Chaos Theory. However, the principle of fractals transcends the linearity of this construct and extends to include archetypal principles and psychology. The rationale behind this is that existence, while often described as energy and it as having various degrees and modes of vibration and frequency, is more accurately described as consciousness or the manifestation of consciousness, or as Divine Mind. Those deeply subscribed to the materialistic paradigm perceive reality as ultimately random and arbitrary, so the notion of it having purpose or existing by design is subconsciously dismissed, and then their perspective is upheld as objectivity, as opposed to the cognitive dissonance that it is.

When this truth is understood, then the initial steps towards a genuine understanding of why Astrology and Horoscopes too can be understood to 'work' can begin. Imagine that, little Horoscopes, otherwise dismissed by ignorant or superficial intellectuality, actually work, because existence is the manifestation of Divine Mind.

Divine Mind, in turn, in its conceptual sense refers to archetypes, or the blueprint principle or inner design of the outer manifestation. Thus, working with Astrology, and Horoscopes too, indicates having access to features of the Divine Plan, by the Divine Mind, of existence, also known as God. In this regard, they truly reveal transcendent, divine will.

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
